Registration Requirements

EAPASA currently has two categories of EAP registration. Full EAP (Environmental Assessment Practitioner) and Candidate EAP.

The following are the requirements needed in order register as an EAP:

- To have a SAQA accredited qualification: Environmental Assessment Practice or be deemed competent based on Recognition of Prior Learning assessment.
- At least three years of appropriate professional experience working on EIAs.
- Have undertaken at least 3 Environmental Impact Assessments or EIA Reviews, Basic Assessments, or Section 24G application, at an appropriate scale, conducted while you held primary responsibility.
- Demonstrate that Core Competencies have been met.
- Application Fee R1500

The following are the requirements needed to register as a Candidate EAP:

- To have a SAQA accredited qualification: Environmental Assessment Practice or be deemed competent based on Recognition of Prior Learning assessment.
- Demonstrate that Core Competencies have been met from a theoretical point of view.
- Pay the R800 Candidate registration fee.
