Amendment of Regulation 22 of the NEMA Section 24H Registration Authority Regulations, 2016



Due to the late publication of the proposed amendments to the regulations, the number of EAPs registered (State Officials and Consultants) to date and the number of applications that still need to be considered by EAPASA, the Minister of Forestry, Fisheries and the Environment, Ms Barbara Creecy has seen it fit to extend the compulsory registration by a further six (6) months.

This extension is meant to provide adequate time to the Department of Forestry, Fisheries and the Environment (DFFE) to adequately consider comments emanating from the public comment process that ensued on 31 December 2021, to allow more time for EAPs to register and allow EAPASA to process registration applications.

We urge all EAPs to make use of this grace period to finalise their applications as non-registered EAPs will not be permitted to carry primary responsibility of EIAs at the end of this period.


CPD Final Submission

EAP REGISTRATION STATUTORY DEADLINE: 08 AUGUST 2022

PLEASE NOTE THAT YOU HAVE 161 DAYS LEFT TO MEET THE LEGISLATIVE REQUIREMENT TO BE A REGISTERED OR CANDIDATE EAP

Please Bear in Mind that - the 120-day Section 24H assessment process commences once:

- 1. The Registrar has deemed your submitted application to be complete, and
- 2. Proof of payment of your registration assessment fee has been received.

Please note:

- You are strongly advised to submit your application as soon as possible to ensure your application is evaluated before 08 August 2022.
- Non-registered EAPs will not be allowed to carry primary responsibility of EIAs after 08 August 2022.
