## **Validated Training Courses and Conferences**

EAPASA's registration is effective for a period of five years. The Section 24H Registration Authority Regulations (Regulation No. 849, Gazette No. 40154 of 22 July 2016, of the National Environmental Management Act (NEMA), Act No. 107 of 1998, as amended) and the National Qualifications Framework (NQF) Act, Act 67 of 2008 provide the foundation for CPD as the legal requirement for the renewal of registration. Therefore, all Registered EAPs are required to submit CPD together with their portfolio of evidence annually for a period of five years so that they can renew their registration for a further five-year period. CPD submission must show activities in three key categories, totaling a minimum of 25 credits over 5 years and should be supported with a portfolio of evidence. It is important to note that CPD credits must be obtained from all three Categories 1, 2 and 3, and some activities are capped to a maximum number of credits in a given year or 5-year period. Category 1 and 3 (c) are compulsory, 5 of the credits must come from category 1, another 5 from category 3 (c) and the other 15 credits can come from any of the three categories. The Environmental Assessment (EA) Professional Development (Category 1) is compulsory as Regulations (17.(2)(b) of Section 24H Registration Authority Regulations requires Registered EAPs to provide evidence that they have updated their skills, knowledge and understanding in the Environmental Assessment field by attending training courses, workshops and conferences etc. as part of their Continuing Professional Development (CPD). EAPASA has validated the following training courses and conferences to enable Registered EAPs to comply with compulsory category 1 requirement. The validation of Training Courses, Workshops and Conferences is continuous and therefore always refer to our website for updates.
